GUIDELINES

1.The tematic of the papers should stick to the paper theme proposed by the organisers..

2. Instructions for Authors. The paper will be written in Microsoft WORD. Page Format: Paper size A4, margins left, right – 20 mm, top and bottom – 20 mm, (Justified), default font TNR 12 pt, line spacing single; Paper Title: on 73 mm, upper case, TNR 14 pt, bold, align center; Authors: Second line under title, TNR 12 pt, bold (including name and institution); Abstract: include a 300 word abstract, second line under authors, TNR, 12 pt, italics; Footnote: in the bottom of the page, TNR, 9 pt; Bibliography: The references, ordered alphabetically, should be at the end of the paper.

3. The presentation of papers: Each participant can present only one paper (author). Research papers should be original, unpublished elsewhere and no longer than 10 pages in length.

Additional materials can be used, such as charts, retroprojectors or Power Point Presentation.

In desired, the use of the last two additional materials shall be announced to the Organizing Comitee along with the sending of the sign up form. Each participant will turn over a copy of the paper at the conference, for the jury.

The time for each presentation is 10 minutes. The extention of the time, over 10 minutes, can be allowed if the jury decides so. The members of the jury can address questions to the authors during the oral presentation and also after it.

4. Evaluation: The papers and the oral presentation will be evaluated by the jury. The consistence of the jury will be determined by rules.

The best papers will be awarded. The jury reserves the right to give special awards.

5.Oficial languages: Romanian, English and French.
